Reading Comprehension

Questions 1-10

The concept of the Kingdom of God is a commonly used idea in the Bible. The Hebrew term is *malkuth*, and the Greek term is *basileia*, both of which mean God's reign or rule. Modern scholars interpret this phrase as having temporal and spatial aspects. The temporal aspect is divided into the present, the present progressive, and

5 the future. The "present" view holds that the Kingdom of God was accomplished

when Jesus came. The “present progressive” view states that this kingdom started with the first coming of Jesus and will be fully achieved in His second coming. The “future” view suggests that the Kingdom of God will be primarily fulfilled in the endtime. The “present progressive” view compares favorably with the tension of the

10 “already” and the “not yet” mentioned in the Scriptures.

The spatial aspect is divided into two: heaven and the heart of the believer. Some scholars see “heaven” as the eschatological location of the Kingdom of God. Others see the “heart of the believer” as reflecting the present location where God reigns—i.e., in the heart of the believer. These temporal and spatial aspects have affected the

15 interpretation of the Kingdom of God in the Synoptic Gospels.
