

## Master of Education (MEd) 교육학석사과정

The Master of Education (MEd) program is a 2-year program for current and future teachers and administrators who desire Christian integration in their vocation. It is mainly designed to produce Christian teachers and administrators who can educate their students based on biblical worldview in primary and secondary schools. The program's emphasis lies on students' Christian worldview formation as well as their acquisition of educational and administrative knowledge and skills through various biblically integrated courses and practices. There are two tracks in this program: Teacher Track and Administrator Track. Teacher Track students can earn the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI) professional teacher certificate. By taking additional courses, Administrator Track students can earn the ACSI principal certificate on top of the teacher certificate.

\* Students must fulfill the field education (FE) requirement in a local church or a Christian organization while they are enrolled at TTGU. In order to receive a P (pass) grade, the student should i) register for Field Education I-II and ii) submit the Field Education report to the Program Director signed by the field supervisor by the 15th week of the semester.

- For graduation, total 36 credits for Teacher track (minimum 26 educational studies credits and 9 biblical studies credits) and 45 credits for Administrator track are required.
- For ACSI Teacher Certificate, 36 credits (Teacher Track requirement) and Practical Field Education I & II are required.
- For ACSI Principal Certificate, 45 credits (Administrator Track requirement) and Practical Field Education I & II are required.
- Courses with \* will be offered biennially.
- The course with \*\* can be replaced upon evaluation of a sample paper (APA format, 5-6 pages, double space, Times New Roman, 12 points) and an editing test.

► **Track A. Teacher Track**

Teacher Track is for any MEd students who want to serve a Christian school as a teacher and/or who is pursuing to receive the ACSI (Association of Christian Schools International) Professional Teacher Certificate. On completion of the program, students in this track will be eligible for the teacher certificate.

▶ **Track B. Administrator Track**

Administrator Track is for any MEd students who want to serve a Christian school as an administrative leader or a principal and/or who is pursuing to receive the ACSI Professional Principal Certificate. On completion of the program, any student in this track will be eligible for both the teacher and principal certificate with some extra course-taking.

\* Administrator Track students might have to pay extra 1 credit fee for three semesters. Up to 2 additional credits over the load (11 credits) are allowed to be taken with extra fee.
