2. Admission Types and Qualifications

Common	Applicants for International Admissions must meet one of the following criteria: 1. An applicant and both parents hold foreign citizenship (Korean nationals with multiple nationalities are not eligible to apply.) 2. An international or Korean national residing abroad who has received education in a foreign country for a minimum of 16 years, from elementary school to university. 3. A North Korean refugee ※ Applicants who do not meet the criteria above must apply for General/Special admissions.
English Program	1. A mature believer who has the assurance of salvation and was baptized (in case of infant baptism, confirmed) at least five years ago as of Feb 28, 2026 2. Must hold an MDiv degree or master's degree in related studies with a minimum GPA of 3.3/4.0 from an accredited university or the legal equivalent 3. Must have an official English test score with a minimum of TOEFL-iBT 71/IELTS 5.5/TEPS 326 (w/ S&W) obtained within the last two years 4. "Intercultural Studies" applicants must have a minimum of three years of intercultural ministry experience.
Korean Program	A mature believer with the assurance of salvation is required 1. Must hold a master's degree in counseling psychology or counseling-related studies from an accredited university 2. Must have an official English score of TOEFL-iBT/IELTS/TEPS obtained within the last two years

1. Paper Screening	- Evaluation of submitted documents
2. Personal Inventory Test (MMPM-II)	- Online test - Respond honestly to questions about various experiences - Required to secure test time and a quiet place (about one hour) - Applicants may take the test in either Korean or English, whichever is more convenient.
3. English Proficiency test	- Must submit an official English of TOEFL-iBT/IELTS/TEPS (w/ S&W) obtained within two years of the application deadline. [Exemptions] - International applicants from countries where English is the official language will be exempt from submitting an English score if they obtained a bachelor's degree or higher in English. English-speaking countries are defined by the "Countries and Regions" list of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Korea (www.mofa.go.kr).
4. Interview	- Interview is conducted individually - Applicants must present a "one-minute speech" on any topic of their choice (e.g., current events, personal stories, the book that impressed them, the reasons for choosing TTGU, what Jesus Christ means in their lives, how to do missions, what the church should be like, etc.) - Interviews are conducted in the language of the applied program. The interviews will be conducted in English and Korean for the English and Korean programs, respectively.

- ※ The written exam has no minimum passing score, and admission is based on the total score. However, applicants scoring below the minimum score in the interview will be disqualified.

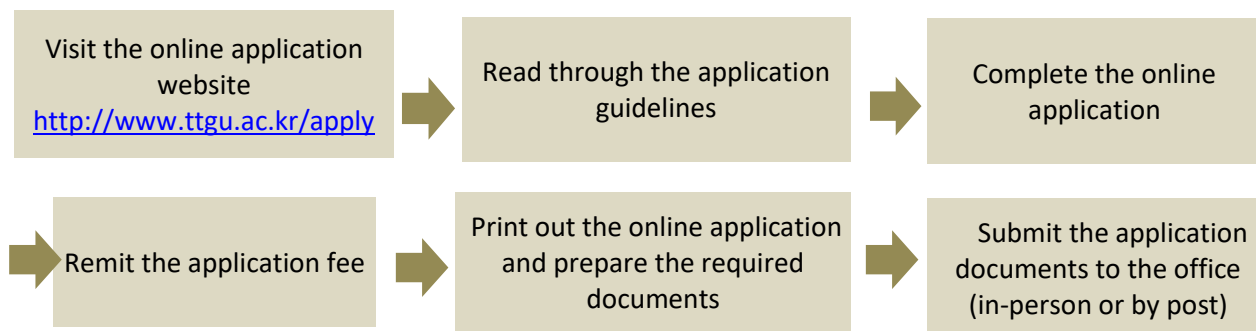

Arrivals after the application deadline cannot be accepted.

3) **Notice for Applicants**

- ① The English name and date of birth must be identical to those on the passport.
- ② Applicants must provide a valid email address.
- ③ Any incomplete application will not be processed. Application or admissions will be automatically canceled if the applicant's submitted documents are found to be forged, falsified, or altered.

- ④ If an applicant decides to withdraw the application before the deadline, the application fee will be refunded after the deduction of the remittance fee. However, after the deadline, the submitted application documents and application fee will not be returned.
- ⑤ If an applicant with a disability requires any assistance or support during the admissions process, he or she must inform the office in advance with a copy of his or her disability registration card.
- ⑥ Applicants **must bring both their identification card and the verification slip** on the day of entrance exams and interview.
- ⑦ If an applicant misses any of the exams or cheats during the exams, he or she will be automatically disqualified.
- ⑧ If an applicant is deemed to be inadequate to become a pastor/Christian minister after the interview, the applicant may be disqualified.

- ✓ **Documents issued in foreign languages other than Korean/English (e.g., Chinese) must be translated into Korean or English, notarized, and submitted.**

- 1) **Printed copy of the online application:** after submitting the online application at www.ttggu.ac.kr/apply, print out one copy to submit to the Admissions Office along with other required documents.

- 2) **Personal Statement [school form]**
- 3) **Graduate certificates of undergraduate degree issued within 3 months of the application deadline**
 - For graduates from Korean universities, the degree registration number must be provided.
 - Graduates of overseas universities must submit the degree certificate referred to in <Appendix 1: Accreditation Certification Approval of Overseas University>.
- 4) **Official transcripts of undergraduate/graduate degrees issued within 3 months of the application deadline**
 - For transfer students, please submit transcripts from all previous colleges/universities attended.
- 5) **One pastoral reference letter [school form]:** by the senior pastor or applicant's spiritual mentor
- 6) **Two academic reference letters [school form]:** by former professors who know the applicant's academic aspects well

- Referees should complete the reference letter form and directly e-mail it to admissions@ttgu.ac.kr or mail it in a sealed and signed envelope.
- **[IMPORTANT] Applicant's family or relatives are ineligible to write a reference letter.**
- If the referee for an English program applicant is unable to write a letter in English, it should be translated by a translator and sent together with the original letter via email or mailed in a sealed and signed envelope.
- References must be delivered by the application deadline.

- 13) **PhD Research Plan** should not exceed 2,000 words (excluding the bibliography). Please ensure that your tentative plan answers the following questions clearly:
 - ① Do you have a clear thesis statement, or have you identified your primary research questions?
 - ② Have you stated why this research is important or what this research will accomplish?

- ③ Have you demonstrated your knowledge of the field by engaging with other scholarly works?
 - ④ Have you explained how you will approach the project (providing at least a brief explanation of the method)?
 - ⑤ Does your research plan include the following elements: Tentative Title, Abstract (maximum 300 words), Tentative Chapter Outline, Introduction, Body, and Conclusion?
- 14) **A copy of passport or alien registration card**
- 15) **A financial statement (school form) and bank statement** (for student-visa applicants only)
Please submit proof of a balance of at least 20,000,000 KRW within the last three months.
For applicants sponsored by a church, school, or scholarship foundation, please submit proof of the sponsor's representative balance of at least 20,000,000 KRW within the last three months.
- 16) **TOPIK Score (for Korean program applicants):** TOPIK level 5 and above is required obtained within two years as of the application deadline.
- If overseas Koreans obtained a bachelor's degree in Korean from a university in Korea, applicants will be exempt from the TOPIK score substituting with a graduate certificate, official transcript, and a certificate of domestic residence report.

- 1) Deposit payment applies only to successful candidates residing in Korea.
- 2) Foreign students residing overseas must pay the full tuition fees for the first semester by Saturday, December 6th, and obtain the 'Certificate of Admission' to proceed with the application for the student visa (D-2).
- 3) New students are not allowed to stop out in the first semester, except for illness, military duty, or maternity.
- 4) Prospective graduates must submit their final graduate certificate and official transcript before matriculation.

8. PhD Scholarship

- 1) Applicants who intend to apply for PhD scholarship must submit the "PhD Scholarship Application."
- 2) Priority will be given to those committed to mission service. The scholarship recipients will receive up to 50% of tuition and must apply for the scholarship each semester.

<Appendix 1: Accreditation Certification Approval of Overseas University>

If an applicant has obtained a degree from an overseas university, an Apostille certificate or consular confirmation must be issued and submitted to prove that the graduate certificate is an official document of the country where the degree was obtained.

For documents not written in Korean or English, a notarized translation in Korean or English must be attached. If you are applying through an agency in Korea, it may take up to two months. We recommend that you apply well in advance of the admission deadline to avoid delays.

1. Graduates from a university in Apostille Convention Country(www.hcch.net/en/home)

- Submit the graduate certificate (or transcript) with an Apostille.
- Apostille issuance procedure

Issuance of graduate certificate (or transcript) in the relevant country → (Notarized by the notarized office in case of private documents) → Visit Apostille issuing organization → Apply for Apostille issuance → Review by Apostille issuing agency → Issuance of Apostille
